NAUSEA & VOMITING ADULT PEDIATRIC BLS Procedures Assess airway, suction airway as needed. Assess vitals. Obtain Sp02 Oxygen. Titrate to Sp02 to 94% or higher. **EMT Optional Scope** ADMINISTRATION OF ONDANSETRON (ZOFRAN) BY EMT IS ONLY APPROVED FOR EMT'S THAT HAVE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED A STANISLAUS COUNTY EMS AGENCY APPROVED TRAINING. Adult Patients Only (18 Years and Up) Ondansetron (Zofran) 4 mg PO Pediatric Ondansetron (under 18 years old) not approved for May repeat once after 15 min EMT's First Trimester Pregnancy (Less Than 12 Weeks) Withhold Ondansetron (Zofran) in First Trimester Pregnancy unless already using via prescription. **ALS Standing Orders** IV access as needed. Obtain ECG. Ondansetron (Zofran) 4 mg PO/IM/IV/IO 2-3 Years Old Slow IV push over 1 minute. Ondansetron (Zofran) 2 mg IM/IV/IO Single max dose 4 mg. Slow IV Push over 1 minute. May repeat every 10 minutes. No repeat Total max dose 12 mg First Trimester Pregnancy (Less Than 12 Weeks) 4 Years and Older Withhold Ondansetron (Zofran) in First Trimester Pregnancy unless Ondansetron (Zofran) 4 mg PO/IM/IV/IO already using via prescription. Slow IV push over 1 minute. No repeat

Special Considerations

- Nausea and Vomiting are signs and symptoms of many other illnesses and or diseases.
- Have a high suspicion of cardiac related conditions or dysrhythmias.

Base Hospital Orders Only

Contact Base Hospital Physician for Doses that exceed written protocol, or for patients under 2 years old.
